

CHAPTER 113: GARAGE SALES

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§ 113.01 DEFINITION.

For the purpose of this Chapter, the following definition shall apply unless the context clearly indicates or requires a different meaning.

GARAGE SALE. All sales on residential property of miscellaneous second-hand merchandise to the public, including, but not limited to, household furnishings, appliances, tools, clothing, and equipment. The term ***GARAGE SALE*** shall further include sales commonly known as rummage sale, moving sale, barn sale, and yard sale.

§ 113.02 RESTRICTIONS.

No individual, association, or corporation shall be permitted to conduct more than two garage sales per residence per calendar year. No individual garage sale shall run more than three consecutive days.

§ 113.03 PERMITS.

No garage sale may be conducted without obtaining a permit from the Village Clerk's office. The permit shall require no fee. The applicant must specify the date, time, and place of the sale, the person conducting the sale, and the type and location of all signs to be posted.

§ 113.04 SIGNS.

No sign shall be nailed to trees or permanently mounted and shall not exceed 24 inches by 24 inches in size.

§ 113.99 PENALTY.

Any individual violating the terms and provisions of this Chapter shall be fined not less than \$25 nor more than \$500 for each violation.
