I. Call to Order

Chairman Weiner called the meeting to order at 8:01 p.m.

II. Roll Call

In attendance included Chairman Weiner, PC Members Kotarski, Ashley, Thelin and Benson. Nelson was absent.

Others included Deputy Clerk Schroeder. There were no members of the public present.

III. Consideration of Approval of August 11, 2020 Planning Commission Meeting Minutes

Motion: Kotarski moved to approve the August 11, 2020 Planning Commission Meeting minutes, seconded by Benson. All Ayes No Nays Motion Carried 5-0 1 absent

IV. Discussion: Golf Cart Summary / Recommendations DRAFT

The PC discussed the golf cart summary drafted by Member Kotarski, based on finding of facts from various surrounding communities, Illinois Statue requirements and previous PC meeting discussion. Further discussion ensued to add a Village map with the summary indicating the restricted roads that golf carts would be prohibited from driving on throughout the Village per State Statue connectivity guidelines.

Ashley suggested issuing golf cart stickers to help keep track of the number of carts in the village as well as using that revenue to help fund any signage costs.

It was also pointed out that HOA trails does not allow golf cart use.

The Planning Commission has determined that the Village should not permit the use of golf carts on Village streets. However, if approved, the Village must enact compliance measures to meet the State required mandates.

Chairman Weiner stated that the summary and draft map would be presented to the Village Board meeting on September 16, 2020 for feedback.

V. Any and/or New Business

Chairman Weiner informed the PC that further discussion on the Village Comprehensive Plan would be on the October Agenda.

Clerk Schroeder asked the Plan Commission if they would consider changing the meeting time from 8:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Kotarski stated that the time of the meeting was set long ago in conjunction with the Village Board meetings which were held at 8:00 p.m.

Kotarski stated that the time worked better for him when he was working, but now since he is not the 7:00 p.m. time would work for him. Ashley noted that 7:00 p.m. would actually work better for him. It was the consensus of the PC that 7:00 p.m. would be a workable time to hold PC public meetings. Chairman Weiner noted that he would bring subject to the Village Board at the meeting next week.

VI. Open to Floor

Chairman Weiner observed there were no members of the public for comments. Open forum was closed at 8:20 p.m.

VII. Adjourn

Motion: Benson moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:24 p.m., seconded by Thelin. Voice
