Avian Flu Outbreak: Forest Preserves of Cook County confirmed that 200 double-crested cormorants were found dead Baker's Lake in Barrington recently in what County officials are calling it the worst outbreak of the avian flu they've seen in years in Cook County. It is hoped that this does not spread to our area birds. People should not touch or interact with a sick or dead bird, or animal. Anyone who sees more than one dead bird at a location is asked to notify the forest preserve district.

You may also put ELECTRONICS at your curb by 7AM where they will be picked up for you!

ITEMS NOT OUT BY 7AM WILL NOT BE REMOVED

Please call the Village Hall with questionable items, or if you need assistance in moving items to your curb.

Accepted Electronics Include: Personal Computers (including tablets)*, Monitors*, Electronic Keyboards*, Mice*, Small Scale Servers*, Printers*, Scanners*, Copiers, Fax Machines*, Digital Converter Boxes*, Cable Receivers*, Satellite Receivers*, VCRs*, DVRs*, DVD Players*, Televisions*, Stereos, Radios, Microwaves, Small Household Appliances, Video Game Consoles* and Accessories, Portable Digital Music Players*

Items should be unboxed.

* Indicates electronics banned from Illinois landfills as of January 1, 2012.

NOTE: EACH HOUSEHOLD IS LIMITED TO 1 (ONE) TV/MONITOR ONLY!!

Not Accepted: No commercial or business materials will be accepted.

No dehumidifiers, air conditioners, large appliances
