*ITEMS NOT OUT BY 7AM WILL NOT BE REMOVED*

Please call the Village Hall with questionable items, or if you need assistance in moving items to your curb.

**Accepted Electronics Include:** Personal Computers (including tablets)\*, Monitors\*, Electronic Keyboards\*, Mice\*, Small Scale Servers\*, Printers\*, Scanners\*, Copiers, Fax Machines\*, Digital Converter Boxes\*, Cable Receivers\*, Satellite Receivers\*, VCRs\*, DVRs\*, DVD Players\*, Televisions\*, Stereos, Radios, Microwaves, Small Household Appliances, Video Game Consoles\* and Accessories, Portable Digital Music Players\*

Items should be unboxed.

\* Indicates electronics *banned* from Illinois landfills

**NOTE: EACH HOUSEHOLD IS LIMITED TO 1 (ONE) TV/MONITOR ONLY!!**

**Not Accepted:** No commercial or business materials will be accepted.

No dehumidifiers, air conditioners, large appliances
