

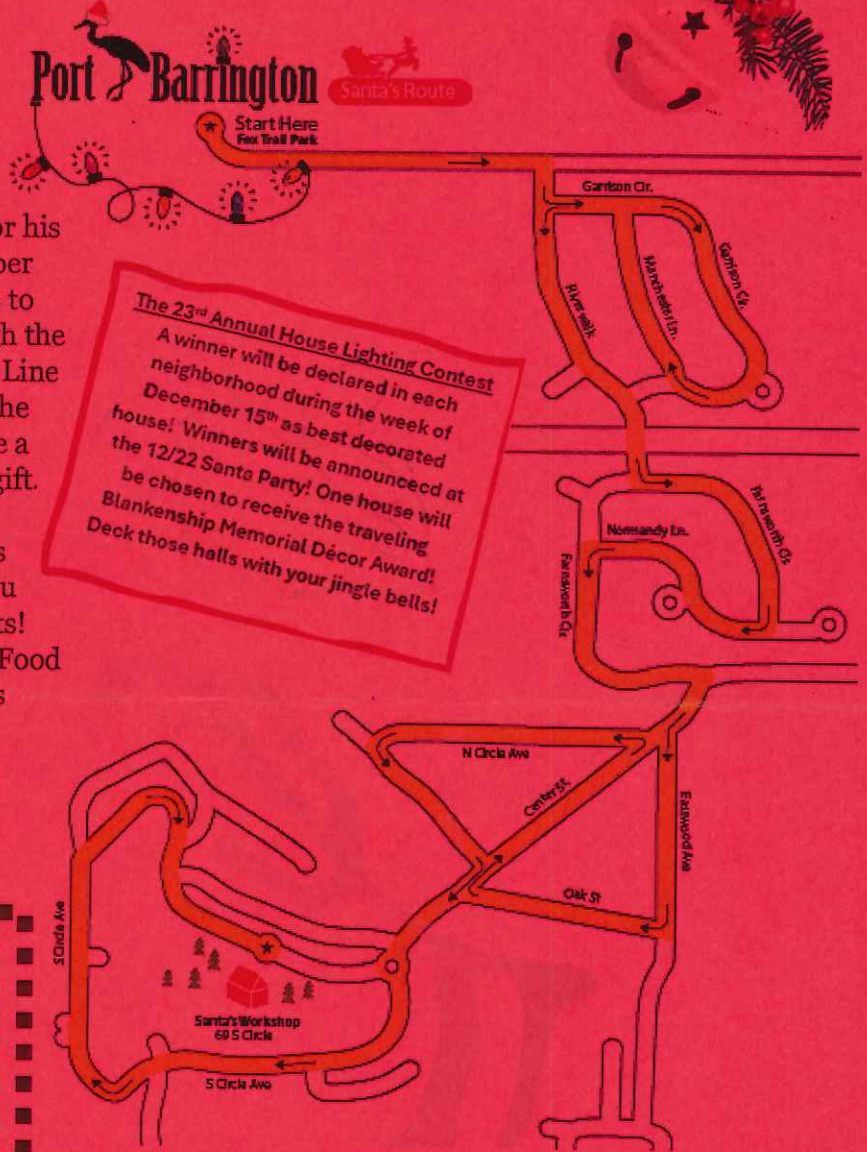
Jingle All the Way...
