Open House Public Meeting Summary

Wednesday, April 9, 2025, a public meeting was held between 6:00-7:00 pm at the Village of Port Barrington Village Hall for the Center Street over the Fox River bridge improvement. There was support and some concern for different aspects of the project. Generally, the public agreed with the recommendations to the bridge with concerns focused on the support under the northern abutment and access to the island during construction. Several in attendance asked how long construction will take. Officially, 15 people signed-in and there were no written comments received at the meeting. Displays showing the proposed improvement were available for viewing. Pictures illustrating how the one-way bridge traffic signal will work were also available.
