

COMMITTEE MEETING OF THE VILLAGE OF PORT BARRINGTON
LAKE AND MCHENRY COUNTIES, ILLINOIS
March 4, 2026

President Vogeler called the monthly Committee Meeting of the Board of Trustees to order at 7:08 pm. The following Trustees were present; Tuke, Jurkowski, Lawrence, Suddeth and Corrigan. Trustee Grothendick was absent.

Minutes of the February 4, 2026 Committee Meeting were before the Board. Trustee Tuke motioned to approve. Trustee Corrigan seconded. Roll call was taken: 5 Ayes, 0 Nays, 1 Absent. Motion approved.

Minutes of the Executive Session from January 07, 2026 were before the Board. Trustee Corrigan motioned to approve. Trustee Tuke seconded. Roll call was taken: 5 Ayes, 0 Nays, 1 Absent. Motion approved.

PLANNING COMMISSION

No new information was presented on this subject.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

Trustee Lawrence had no new information to present on this subject.

STREETS AND ROADS

Trustee Corrigan stated he was working on a budget for the road program and would present information at the next Board Meeting.
Street sweeping will be performed on 02/25/2026.

FORESTRY

Trustee Corrigan stated he would purchase trees. Rusty stated that three parkway trees had to be replaced. There was discussion of bushes for the berm.

PARKS AND RECREATION

Trustee Suddeth stated he is working on the open lands grant due next Wednesday.
Trustee Jurkowski stated that the annual egg hunt would be held on April 4, 2026.
The Recreation Committee wants to hold a touch-a-truck event on April 18 at the Broken Oar. If they can't get 5 or more trucks to participate they will not pursue.

COMMUNITY RELATIONS

Trustee Tuke is seeking nominations for the Challenge Coin presentation and needs application forms.

There are no applications, yet, for the scholarships.

BUILDING AND ZONING

President Vogeler stated the Speakeasy at No Wake was to remain closed until the fire department inspected. The owner claimed it was accomplished, but it was not. Additional work must be completed there.

FINANCE

Donna Erfort stated that budget meetings will be scheduled. The Clerk asked about the unallocated fund and whether the next budget would include that.

President Vogeler stated at the Mayor's meetings all participants talk about lowering taxes.

TREASURER

Donna stated that the Economic Interest statements are due May 1, 2026.

ADMINISTRATOR

There is an offer to purchase properties on Pine Street that are not contiguous to Fox Trail Park. They must sell for 80% of appraised value. In 2018 there was an opinion from the then Village Attorney recommending we do not sell due to costs to the Village.

There are five applicants for summer help.

PUBLIC WORKS

Rusty is looking into lawn mowers for budgeting purposes.

ENGINEER

The road engineer met with Zach for outfall inspections.

Trustee Corrigan and a Manhard representative met with the moorings HOA.

VILLAGE PRESIDENT

President Vogeler stated that two ice fishermen were rescued when they fell through the ice. There are more people coming to the Village Hall to complain about vehicle tax collection. Georgina made a complaint form. The collection firm has collected money.

OLD/NEW

Trustee Corrigan stated that MSC Collections contract shows them exclusively entitled to collect the debt. The Village should not collect for less at the Village Hall and still have to pay 30% to them.

The meeting was open to the floor at 7:52. No questions or comments were heard.

Trustee Corrigan motioned to adjourn. Trustee suddeth seconded. Roll call was taken: 5 Ayes, 0 Nays, 1 Absent. Motion approved.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:53 pm.
