

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF  
THE VILLAGE OF PORT BARRINGTON BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
LAKE AND MCHENRY COUNTIES, ILLINOIS

April 22, 2026

President Vogeler called the regularly scheduled Meeting of the Board of Trustees to order at 7:07 pm. The following Trustees were present: Trustees Tuke, Jurkowski, Grothendick, Lawrence, Suddeth and Corrigan. Village Attorney, Lisa Waggoner, was present.

Trustee Grothendick motioned to set the agenda, affirming no conflicts of interest. Trustee Tuke seconded. Roll call as taken: 6 Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Absent. Motion approved.

Trustee Suddeth motioned to approve the consent agenda including the regular Board minutes of March 18, 2025, Special Board Meeting of April 1, 2026, and the March 2026 Treasurer's Report. Trustee Lawrence seconded. Roll call was taken: 6 Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Absent. Motion approved.

Bills payable through April 22, 2026 was before the Board. Trustee Tuke motioned to approve the Bills Payable. Trustee Jurkowski seconded. Roll call was taken: 6 Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Absent. Motion approved.

#### PLANNING COMMISSION

Pam Hallet and Vince Russo were present to propose annexing the land along Darrell Road to ensure the Village has input on development. It is the narrow strip that connects Deer Grove and Deer Grove II. President Vogeler stated it is unincorporated Lake County but within the Village corporate boundaries. Mr. Russo stated he would get more information for the Board.

President Vogeler stated there was an inquiry about the 27 acre property on the SE corner of Roberts and Darrell Roads. He told them it is zoned residential.

Vince Russo stated that a resident on Noble Drive told him that someone was on his property claiming to be surveying. He was concerned about preserving the trees there. President Vogeler responded there is a tree preservation requirement built into the subdivision.

#### COMMUNITY RELATIONS

Trustee Tuke stated there were two excellent candidates for the Village scholarships. He suggested a future scholarship be available for firefighters etc.

President Vogeler commended Trustee Tuke on updates for flooding through our social media channels.

Trustee Tuke stated the first Honor Coin recipient was present. He read a certificate to honor Jason Suddeth and presented him with the certificate and coin.

#### HEALTH AND SAFETY

Trustee Lawrence stated that Emily Projansky is working on the water level gauge for the Village.

Trustee Grothendick stated a letter was received about the Village Siren. The name of the system is Rapid Warn. Sirens are triggered by the National Weather Service any time there are winds at 70mph or there is hail with a severe thunderstorm. It is not only for tornadoes. It has been updated to only go off for a tornado warning. The parameters are set by Wauconda. Two of the four horns are not working.

#### STREETS AND ROADS

Ordinance 2026-04-01 was before the Board with amendment to Chapter 70 to reflect no vehicle tax. Trustee Corrigan motioned to approve the ordinance. Trustee Suddeth seconded. Roll call was taken: 6 Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Absent. Motion approved.

#### FORESTRY

Trustee Corrigan stated he was planning a celebration for Arbor Day at the new Eastwood Park, but it is under water.

The Village has been awarded Tree City USA again.

Trustee Corrigan stated he has \$8,000.00 for trees. He motioned to purchase bushes and shrubs for behind the berm at a cost not to exceed \$1,500.00. Trustee Suddeth seconded. Roll call was taken: 6 Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Absent. Motion approved.

#### PARKS AND RECREATION

Trustee Jurkowski stated that the Touch-A-Truck event at the Broken Oar was very well attended.

#### FINANCE

The Village Budget for the fiscal year 2026-2027 as previously discussed was before the Board. With one adjustment Trustee Grothendick motioned to approve the budget. Trustee Suddeth seconded. Roll call was taken: 6 Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Absent. Motion approved.

President Vogeler stated he sent a letter to the Moorings HOA because they have not hired an engineer. They were supposed to complete the project by May 1, 2026. He read the letter to the Board. A response was received on 04/15/2026 that they hope to sign an engineering firm by the end of the week. The Moorings are allowing Port Barrington Shores residents to park there during the flood. The HOA from PBS was asking if the easement could be used by personal vehicles. Lisa Waggoner recommended that the Village not dictate the use of the land.

#### TREASURER

Georgina stated there were increased bills for the copier due to increased copies.

#### PUBLIC WORKS

There has been lots of sandbagging due to the flooding.

A new part time worker will start next week.

#### VILLAGE PRESIDENT

President Vogeler stated the Mayor of North Barrington went to Springfield to present a letter in opposition to build legislation. All local mayors signatures were included.

The owner of No Wake and Pier 91 made a big berm. He approached the HOA from the Moorings and PBS with a proposal to raise Kazimour Road by 6-8". It is in Lake Barrington.

The Village must educate all residents about the disposal of sandbags. Nunda Township will pick them up. Trustee Tuke will post on social media about wells in flood zones.

There were newer residents taking sandbags who are not in a flood zone. President Vogeler suggested a drone video to document what the flooding looks like during a high-water event.

It was estimated 12,000 sandbags were filled. There was 156 tons of sand delivered by Cuba, Wauconda and Nunda townships. President Vogeler stated he wants to set up procedures for flood events with assigned contacts and sourcing materials. As part of the CRS there is a list of those who buy flood insurance and are sent information about flood protocol.

#### OLD/NEW

Trustee Suddeth suggested that LRS drop a bin for trash disposal at Park and Eastwood where residents were affected by the flood.

The meeting was open to the floor at 8:43pm.

No questions or comments were heard.

Trustee Corrigan motioned to adjourn. Trustee Suddeth seconded. Roll call was taken; 6 Ayes, 0 Nay, 0 Absent. Motion approved.

The Board meeting was adjourned at 8:46 pm.
